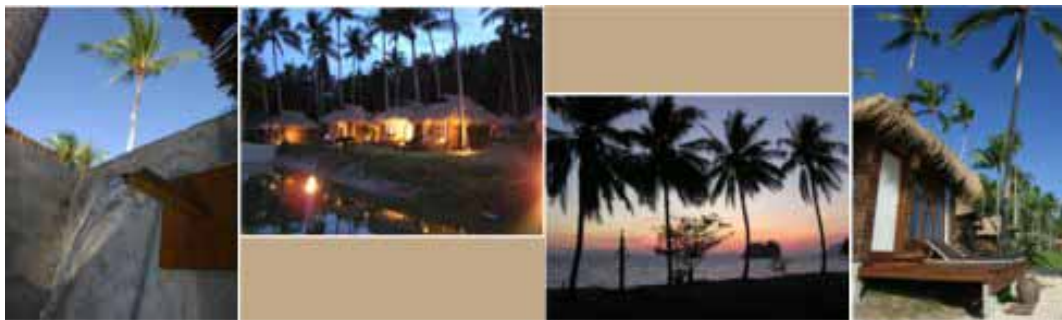
All rooms at CoCo Cottage are decorated in natural style, with extensive use of wood.

How to Get Here

Actually, Koh Ngai is a part of Mu Koh Lanta National Park, Lanta District, Krabi Province. But it is considered to the tourist attraction of Trang Sea because transportation from Trang is more convenient to access via Pakmeng Pier in Trang.

1. From Bangkok to Trang

By Train

Rapid and express trains depart from Bangkok Railway Station to Trang Railway Station daily, taking 15 hours for the 870-kilometer journey. By Air

By Bus

First-class or second-class air-conditioned bus depart from the Southern Bus Terminal on Borom Ratchachonnani Road in Bangkok to Trang every day, taking 12 hours for the trip. By Car

1. Taking Highway No. 4 (Bangkok-Chumphon) to Highway No. 41 (Surat Thani-Thung Song- Huai Yot-Trang), total distance of 828 kilometers.

2. Taking Highway No. 4 (Bangkok-Chumphon) to Ranong-Phannga-Krabi-Trang, total distance of 1,020 kilometers.
